

2021-22 LEARNING PLAN

TIMETABLE AND CLASS SCHEDULE

After examining the information currently provided by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education and reviewing our school building for classes, movement, and overall safety, we have adjusted our normal timetable and schedule to provide us with some flexibility to make adjustments if needed as the year progresses. This is the same timetable as the 2020-21 school year where we have reduced the number of courses that a student and teacher will see per day to reduce contact, improve social distancing, and reduce movement within the school.

Here are the basics of where we will begin in September 2021:

- We will be on a 4-day rotation with 4 77 minute periods per day with a 50 min lunch.
- Each day will consist of two double periods. There will be two lunch periods.
- The homeroom period will take place with their period 1 teacher.

3 POSSIBLE LEARNING SCENARIOS

There are 3 scenarios to the Learning Plan - Traditional, Hybrid/Blended, and Remote. We have designed our timetable to allow us the flexibility to move seamlessly from one scenario to another without the need to make major adjustments.

We will determine which scenario we are in based on the guidance from the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health. As of August 3, 2021, the Ontario Ministry of Education has stated that all schools will be permitted to open fully in-person (Traditional) with an adjusted daily timetable and safety protocols in place.

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FURTHER EXPLANATION OF TRADITIONAL LEARNING

If we are in a Traditional Learning Model all grade levels and students will be taking part in in-person learning for the entire time. All classes will follow the timetable outlined above with appropriate safety protocols such as masking, distancing, sanitizing, etc. These protocols will be based on the documents received by the Ontario Ministries of Health and Education.

FURTHER EXPLANATION OF FULLY REMOTE (ONLINE) LEARNING

If a particular cohort or the entire school is moved to a fully remote (online) learning model all classes will follow the timetable outlined above. All classes and interactions with the teachers will take place via Zoom and Gmail. Access to the Zoom classes will be found in Edsby on the students class page pinned in the top left area of the page.

FURTHER EXPLANATION OF HYBRID/BLENDED LEARNING

If a reduction in the number of students and staff is required during the school year, we are required to move to a Hybrid(or Blended) learning model the following would take place:

- We have determined we will be able to have 4 grades in the school at once and 2 grades at home doing online synchronous Zoom learning.
- As per the Ministry of Education Guidelines, all Grade 7 & 8 students will be receiving in school learning every day.
- Grades 9-12 will be at school 50% of the time
- The grades that are at home each day will be receiving live synchronous learning with their teachers.
- The schedule for students being at home will be based on two 4 day cycles as follows to ensure students receive an equal amount of in-person and online learning in each subject.
