UNIFORM POLICY SEPTEMBER 2021

Please read the following and discuss it with your son/daughter.

Crestwood Preparatory College students are required to wear a uniform when they come to school. There are several advantages to uniforms - too many to outline here. Students are again advised that the new school year will require their participation and full cooperation in not only having the proper uniform items at school, but also wearing them properly.

In that respect, the following needs to be kept in mind as parents and students prepare for the 2017-2018 school year.

- 1. Undersized, oversized and specifically altered uniform items, particularly shirts, will not be allowed. Parents should be on the lookout for short tops, short skirts and short ties.
- 2. **Dress** shoes with any colour other than black on any part of the shoe, will not be allowed. This includes camouflaging what are essentially running shoes as dress shoes. The shoe industry has been capable of producing extremely comfortable dress shoes for some time. Gym shoes are gym shoes, regardless of color, and will not be permitted.
- 3. Dress shirt/blouses must be tucked. Students who wish to wear golf shirts over their pants or skirts must ensure that they are no more than two inches over the belt.
- 4. Please print students' names on all clothing items.
- 5. The locker rooms are not change rooms. "Changing" to go home has its limits.
- 6. School secretaries are not responsible for ordering and/or delivering clothing items. While we may accommodate a student in an emergency, purchases and deliveries must be arranged with Mr. David Cunningham and his staff.

GIRLS' UNIFORMS

- School tie
- Navy blazer or Crestwood sweater
- Blazer will be required for Special events
- Grey tights or grey knee socks

BOYS' UNIFORM

- Grey pants
- School tie
- Navy blazer or Crestwood sweater
- Blazer will be required for Special events
- Grey or black socks
- black leather or leather- like shoes (not running shoes)

Gym Uniforms (male & female)

- navy Crestwood t-shirt
- grey Crestwood shorts (warm weather)
- navy Crestwood sweatshirt
- grey Crestwood sweatpants
- running shoes

Students are expected to be clean, shaven and neatly dressed. Unreasonable hairstyles, excessive jewellery, and body piercing or tattooing is unacceptable. Crestwood reserves the right to determine acceptable standards and to notify parents when these standards are not being met.

Please do everything you can to see that your son or daughter is properly attired each school day. Students who are chronically out of uniform will be sent home until the issue is addressed.
